India plans to attract firms leaving China

As more firms are planning to leave China India is trying to woo them with special benefits and subsidies. A total area of 461,589 hectares has been identified across the country for land allotment to the companies. This is twice the size of Luxembourg which is spread across 243000 hectares.
